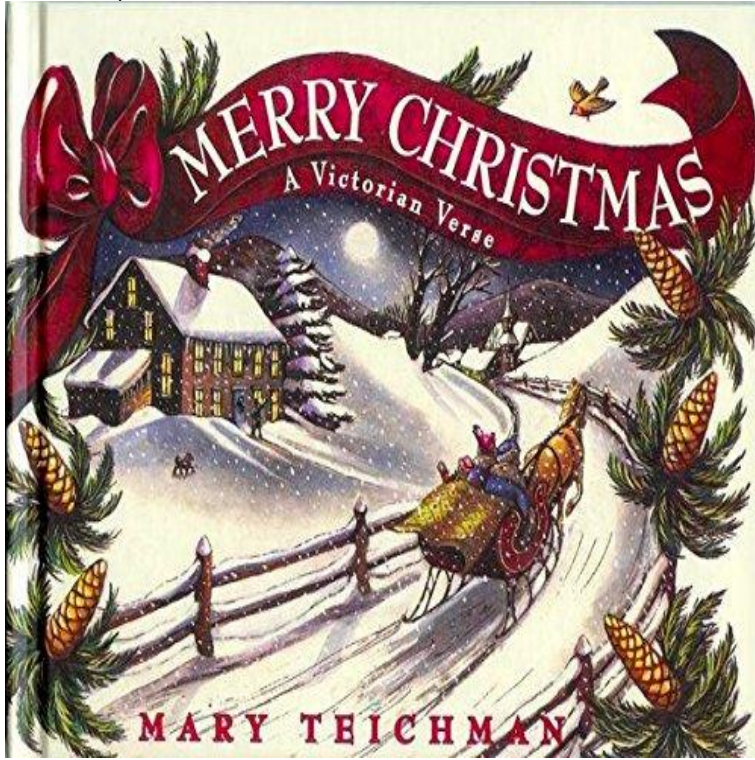


Merry Christmas: A Victorian Verse
